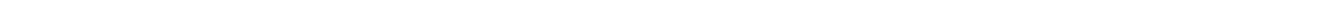

## **Minute of the meeting of Strathclyde Partnership for Transport's Strategy & Programmes Committee held at 131 St Vincent Street and via Video Conference\* on 14 June 2024**

## 5. People and Place Programme

There was submitted a report (issued) of 4 June 2024 by the Head of Policy and Planning recommending the Committee approve SPT's proposed People and Place Programme (PPP) for 2024/2025, funded by Transport Scotland.

After hearing from Mr Kiloh and Mrs Davidson in response to members' questions particularly with regard to:

- details of the projects for which funding is being sought; and
- the limited scope of spend of the funding i.e. active travel and behavioural change

the Committee:

- (i) noted the contents of the report and that Mr Kiloh will provide a summary of all of the projects approved for funding;
- (ii) approved the People and Place Programme "Priority" projects to be delivered in 2024/2025 as detailed in Appendix 1 to the report;
- (iii) agreed to Grant Fund the councils and other delivery partners for those awards for the "Priority" projects up to the value of £200,000 and authorised that grant award letters be concluded in line with good governance arrangements;
- (iv) agreed to recommend to the Partnership meeting of 28 June 2024 approval to Grant Fund councils and other delivery partners for the "Priority" projects with a cumulative value greater than £200,000; and
- (v) noted the People and Place Programme "Pipeline" projects as detailed in Appendix 2 to the report.
